

The Ice Rescue Carabiner (Part Number 6152N) comes with a captive eye pin (Part Number 6152P) which can be installed by the user to eliminate carabiner rotation, which can lead to cross loading, and reduce the risk of losing your Ice Rescue Carabiner. The captive eye pin is removable in the event the need to replace the sling or carabiner arises. A new captive eye pin should be used each time a pin is mounted into the Ice Rescue Carabiner.

Carabiner is shipped without the captive eye pin installed.

To install the captive eye pin:

- 1) Don your Personal Protective Equipment
- 2) Put the sling, or portion of rope you want captured into place in the captive eye
- 3) Start the non-knurled (tapered) end of the captive eye pin into the external hole in the carabiner
- 4) Gently tap the knurled end of the captive eye pin with a hammer, driving the pin into place until flush with the body of the Ice Rescue Carabiner.

To remove the captive eye pin:

- 1) Firmly grasp the center of the pin with vice grip type pliers
- 2) Gently tap the vice grips near the pin with a hammer, driving the pin out until the knurled end can be pulled with pliers.

Caution: If you hit your finger, or any other part of your body with a hammer, it will hurt, and may cause injury. Don't do that.

Caution: Eye Protection and other appropriate Personal Protective Equipment should be worn at all times when installing captive eye pin.
