WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

OBJECTIVE	Dive Rescue International's renowned program for public safety swiftwater responders teaches the knowledge and skills needed to successfully organize and manage these inherently dangerous and complicated events to maximize positive outcomes. This training course includes complete Swiftwater 1 & 2 Rescue training.
JUSTIFICATION	In combination, Swiftwater Rescue 1 & 2 training is completed in five days instead of what would normally require six days to complete. This efficiency saves valuable agency work hours.
CERTIFICATION •	Technician level certification addressing NFPA 1006 and 2500 Chapter 16, Surface Water Search and Rescue; and Chapter 17, Swiftwater Search and Rescue.
RECOMMENDED FOR	All first responders who may at anytime be faced with rescue in quick moving water.
