WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

OBJECTIVE • Dive Rescue International's renowned program for public safety swiftwater responders teaches the knowledge and skills needed to successfully organize and manage these inherently dangerous and complicated events to maximize positive outcomes. This training course includes complete Swiftwater 1 & 2 Rescue training.

JUSTIFICATION • In combination, Swiftwater Rescue 1 & 2 training is completed in five days instead of what would normally require six days to complete. This efficiency saves valuable agency work hours.

CERTIFICATION • Technician level certification addressing NFPA 1006 and 2500 Chapter 16, Surface Water Search and Rescue; and Chapter 17, Swiftwater Search and Rescue.

RECOMMENDED FOR • All first responders who may at anytime be faced with rescue in quick moving water.

DURATION • 5 Days / 40 training hours

TUITION • \$900.00 (US Funds) per student

BE SURE TO BRING • Swiftwater appropriate: U.S. Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Device with knife and whistle, wet suit or dry suit, fins, and helmet
Rope handling gloves

- PREREQUISITES** ● Students must be at least 18 years of age and affiliated with a public safety agency.
This program is designed for personnel who are physically fit. Participants are encouraged to participate after successfully completing the IADRS Watermanship Test or testing to a fitness level of 13 MET (Metabolic Equivalents) or greater. Participants with aerobic fitness questions or concerns should consult their physician prior to in-water training. Participants should expect multiple, challenging in-water exercises.

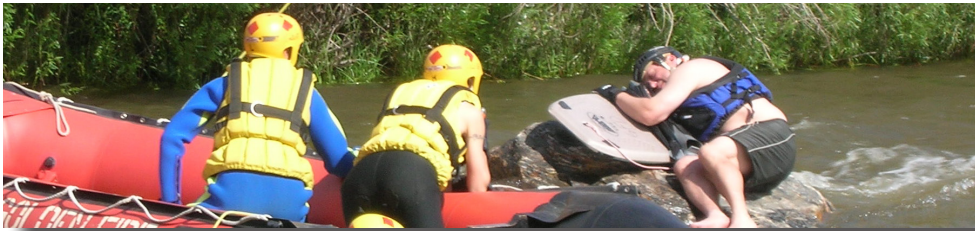

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

OBJECTIVE • Uniquely designed for public safety personnel, graduates of this course return to their department with the tools and skills to train their own department personnel into competent and safe swiftwater responders.

JUSTIFICATION • Departments with their own swiftwater rescue trainer on staff realize significant cost and logistical benefits and allows in-house swiftwater training for the nominal cost of student kits.

CERTIFICATION • Swiftwater Rescue I and II Trainer addressing standards found in chapter 17 of NFPA 1006 and 2500.

RECOMMENDED FOR • Any public safety personnel who respond to events in moving water.

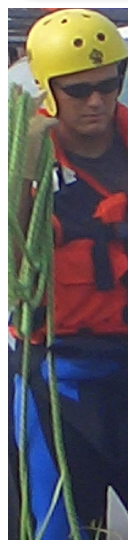
DURATION • 5 Days / 75 training hours

TUITION • \$1,100.00 (US Funds) per candidate
Includes preparatory materials, trainer manual, and presentation materials for instruction to students.

BE SURE TO BRING • All students will be required to wear business attire, including coat and tie, during all classroom sessions. Women may wear dress, skirt, blazer and slacks, etc.

US Coast Guard approved and swiftwater appropriate PFD with cutting tool and whistle, adequate clothing and protection from the environment and pen and paper for note-taking and sketching. All candidates must bring rope handling gloves, helmet, swiftwater appropriate exposure suit, fins, boogie board, gloves, and footwear.

Swimsuit, mask, fins, snorkel, and swim goggles.
