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## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

**OBJECTIVE** ¶

Dry suit diving with a full face mask helps public safety divers insulate themselves from environmental hazards.

Chemical, biological, and thermal hazards are addressed and mitigated with this crucial equipment and diver training.

**JUSTIFICATION** 

This training prepares divers to use dry suits and full face masks addressing NFPA suggested standards.

**CERTIFICATION** 

Dry Suit Diver Full Face Mask Diver

**RECOMMENDED FOR** 

All in-water operators who respond to public safety dive events.

**DURATION** 

3 Days / 24 training hours

**TUITION** 

\$450.00 (US Funds) per student Includes training manual

**BE SURE TO BRING** 

US Coast Guard approved PFD with knife and whistle, adequate clothing and protection from the environment and pen and paper for note-taking and sketching. Diving students must provide their own equipment: Wetsuit and drysuit, scuba regulator: recently serviced and environmentally protected with alternate air source (i.e.: octopus, Air II, etc.), timing device, depth and submersible pressure gauge, BC with oral/power inflator, two tanks with current Hydro & VIP, mask, snorkel, fins, weight belt, two cutting tools (knife, wire cutters, or trauma shears) and full face mask.
