MAKING IT HAPPEN

PREREQUISITES

Swiftwater Rescue I & II students must be at least 18 years of age.

Swiftwater Rescue II students must have basic Swiftwater Rescue training or from a recognized training agency issued within 3 years before the start of class.

Swiftwater Rescue Trainer students must be at least 21 years of age. A Surface Medical Statement is required to participate. Trainer candidates must complete an application prior to class, as well as submit proof of First Aid, proof of CPR, and a Letter of Sponsorship. Candidates must provide proof of Swiftwater Rescue training from a recognized training agency issued within 3 years before the start of class and proof of completed Swiftwater Rescue II training through Dive Rescue International.

All participants must be affiliated with a public safety agency.

These programs are designed for personnel who are physically fit. Participants are encouraged to participate after successfully completing the IADRS Watermanship Test or testing to a fitness level of 13 MET (Metabolic Equivalents) or greater. Participants with aerobic fitness questions or concerns should consult their physician prior to in-water training. Participants should expect multiple, challenging in-water exercises

BRING TO CLASS

Swiftwater appropriate: U.S. Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Device with knife and whistle, wet suit or dry suit, fins, and helmet Rope handling gloves Pen and paper for note taking Dry change of clothes

All who attend the Trainer portion of the series will be required to wear business attire, including coat and tie, during all classroom sessions
