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MAKING IT HAPPEN

PREREQUISITES

- At least 21 Years of Age
- Member of a Public Safety Agency
- Trainer Application Including:
 - Proof of Swiftwater Rescue Training from a recognized training agency issued within 3 years of start of class and completion of Swiftwater Rescue II through Dive Rescue International
 - Physician Clearance to Participate
 - Letter of Sponsorship
- Proof of First Aid and CPR
- This course is designed for individuals who are physically fit (testing to 13 MET or better)

BRING TO CLASS

- All students will be required to wear business attire, including coat and tie, during all classroom sessions. Women may wear dress, skirt, blazer and slacks, etc.
- US Coast Guard approved and swiftwater appropriate PFD
- Cutting Tool
- Whistle
- Adequate clothing and protection for the environment
- Pen and Paper for note-taking and sketching.
- **All candidates must bring:** rope handling gloves, helmet, swiftwater appropriate exposure suit, fins, boogie board, gloves, footwear, swimsuit, mask, fins, snorkel, and swim goggles.
