MAKING IT HAPPEN

PREREQUISITES

- All students must be a member of a Public Safety Agency
- At least 21 years of age.
- Public Safety Scuba Instructor or certified and current recreational scuba instructor.
- Current First Aid and CPR Training.
- Completed Medical Questionnaire signed by a physician.
- Successful completion of Dive Rescue 1, two advanced diving courses (Dive Rescue II certification) and Med Dive.
- This program is designed for personnel who are physically fit. Participants are encouraged to participate after successfully completing the IADRS Watermanship Test or testing to a fitness level of 13 MET (Metabolic Equivalents) or greater.
- Participants with aerobic fitness questions or concerns should consult their physician prior to in-water training. Participants who have poor aerobic fitness may attend this program as surface support personnel with the approval of the instructor.

BRING TO CLASS

US Coast Guard approved PFD with knife and whistle, adequate clothing and protection from the environment and pen and paper for note-taking and sketching.

Diving students must provide their own equipment: Wetsuit or dry suit, scuba regulator: recently serviced + environmentally protected with alternate air source (i.e.: octopus), timing device, depth + submersible pressure gauge, BC with oral/power inflator, 2 tanks with current Hydro + VIP, mask, snorkel, fins, weight belt + 2 cutting tools (knife, wire cutters, or trauma shears).
