MAKING IT HAPPEN

PREREQUISITES

- Be a member of a public safety agency.
- At least 18 years old.
- Complete a Recreational Scuba Training Council (RSTC) Medical Statement. If any questions are answered affirmatively, a physician's signature is required.
- Provide proof of open water scuba certification (required for diving students; surface support personnel are exempt).
- If participating in dry suit diving, submit proof of dry suit
- While not mandatory, it's recommended that participants have a fitness level equivalent to 13 MET (Metabolic Equivalents) or successfully complete the International Association of Dive Rescue Specialists (IADRS) Watermanship Test. Those with lower fitness levels may attend as surface support personnel with instructor approval

BRING TO CLASS

US Coast Guard approved PFD with knife and whistle, adequate clothing and protection from the environment and pen and paper for note-taking and sketching.

Diving students must provide their own equipment: Wetsuit or dry suit, scuba regulator: recently serviced + environmentally protected with alternate air source (i.e.: octopus), timing device, depth + submersible pressure gauge, BC with oral/power inflator, 2 tanks with current Hydro + VIP, mask, snorkel, fins, weight belt + 2 cutting tools (knife, wire cutters, or trauma shears).

TRAVEL

Check with Dive Rescue International to confirm class before making airline reservations.
